About Colin....

Colin Wilson is 23 years old. He was diagnosed with Cystic Fibrosis, which is a genetic terminal lung disease, at six months of age. For the past 23 years he has fought this battle and his lungs have become progressively worse. To the point of needing a transplant. Colin is currently taking 14 medications, including inhaled antibiotics and digestion medicine. He does airway clearance every day to keep the lungs from building up bacteria which cause lung infections. Within the past 2 years, this disease has progressed to the point that he has to be hospitalized almost every other month since September 2015. The progression of the disease is severe enough that UNC Chapel Hill is evaluating him to be placed on the double lung transplant waiting list. The out-of-pocket related expenses are estimated to be \$40,000 over what insurance covers. The funds raised from this event will go to COTA in honor of Colin to help Colin and his family in their quest to reach this goal and a healthier and happier quality of life for Colin.
